- \_\_\_ 6. FRG funding is necessary to complete this project.
- \_\_\_ 7. Reviewers can easily follow the summary and review of relevant literature to understand the purpose of the project.
- \_\_\_ 8. The hypothesis, research question, or scholarly intent is (are) clearly articulated.
